

Victoria Cherry Rhubarb

Rheum rhabarbarum

Very popular for pies, sauces and canning. Tart flavored, succulent, perennial plant providing vigorous, red, heavy, thick stalks.

Grows well in all climates but prefers cool seasons.

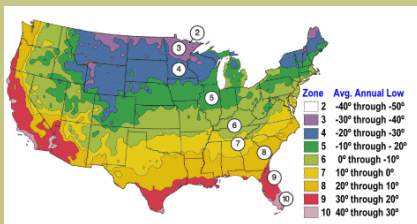
Plant root divisions in 5 foot rows, 3 feet apart in well drained soil with shade.

As a seedling grown plant, some variation of color will be evident between plants.

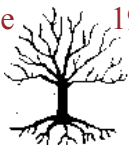
Mature height is 2-3 feet with a spread of 2-3 feet.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 3.

Caution: eat stalks only, leaves are toxic



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
